



Establishing Domicile

While this is not an all-inclusive list, to begin setting up domicile, you at least need to do the following:

- Change car registration
- Change driver's license
- Change voter's registration
- Establish religious affiliations such as churches, synagogues, etc.
- Move personal items
- Update insurance policies
- File for homestead exemption, if applicable
- Develop social affiliations such a country clubs, dining clubs, etc.
- Execute a new will and any applicable trusts
- Open new bank accounts and brokerage accounts

Beware of:

New York City Parking Exemption and New York State Fishing License

Depending upon your individual circumstances and location, there may be additional steps you need to take.
